



## School Profile

Woodstream Christian Academy (WCA) is a K-12 classical Christian school that offers a rigorous college preparatory education. As a classical Christian school, the Academy embraces the Trivium and has the following departments: Early Childhood Education (K-2 – K-3), Pre-Grammar (K-4 – Grade 2), The School of Grammar (Grade 3 – Grade 6), The School of Logic (Grade 7 – Grade 8), and The School of Rhetoric (Grade 9 – Grade 12). Committed to academic and spiritual excellence, WCA exists as a community of learning that equips students spiritually, intellectually, emotionally, physically, and socially. The Academy provides an environment that not only challenges students, but also creates within them a passion for learning and stirs up a desire for godly behavior so that they may reach their highest possible potential.

When the Academy opened its doors on September 2, 2003, it welcomed 54 students in K-4 and K-5. In September 2004, the Academy expanded to accommodate students in K-2 through Grade 8. By the school's third year, the Academy received students in Grade 9, thus marking the beginning of the School of Rhetoric. The 2008-2009 school year will mark another significant milestone for the Academy for the following two reasons. First, the Academy has received the recommendation for full accreditation by the Association of Christian Schools International and the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools for its academic program; the final vote by the accreditation boards will take place in December 2008. Second, Woodstream Christian Academy will graduate its first students, the Class of 2009, on May 22, 2009. The goal of the Academy is to develop students who have a lifelong commitment to intellectual and ethical excellence so that they may be effectual influences in the world in which we live. *Soli Deo Gloria.*
