

Six Core Areas of Development

Spiritual Development

This is the child's ability to learn to worship God through prayers, singing and Bible stories.

Cognitive Development

This is the child's ability to learn and solve a problem.

Social and Emotional Development

This is the child's ability to interact with others, including helping themselves and self-control.

Speech and Language Development

This is the child's ability to both understand and use language.

Fine Motor Skills Development

This is the child's ability to use small muscles, specifically their hands and fingers, for example: to pick up small objects, hold a spoon, turn pages in a book, use a crayon to draw, zip a zipper or button a shirt, etc.

Gross Motor Skills Development

This is the child's ability to use large muscles, for example: throwing a ball, marching, walking a straight line, jumping, walking down stairs, etc.

K-2 Information

- Tuition for K-2 students includes the following: Academic Instruction and Care from 6:45 AM to 6:00 PM, AM/PM snacks, and lunch.
- K-2 uses the following curricula: Abeka 2's/3's; Bible, Numbers and Letters Sounds, Kumon 2's; Cutting, Coloring and Pasting.
- “Fun at Home” homework is given on a weekly basis.
- Uniforms are required for K-2 students.
- K-2 is a year round program with June or September start dates. (Federal Holidays and Breaks customary to schools are observed. Calendars will be provided.)
- K-2 students must be 2-years of age by the start date.
- K-2 students are not required to be potty trained.
- Family interviews will be conducted with every family. One recommendation is required. K-2 students will not be formally assessed; however, a readiness survey will be taken.
