Project Redemptive Love's After-School and Enrichment

Program is a free service offered on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons from 3:15 pm to 5:30 pm from October through May as well as optional sessions in the summer. Students are served a snack and have time for



recreation. Second through sixth grade students receive instruction and tutoring in math, reading, writing, technology, art, music, character education, and Bible stories. Services for exceptional students are limited at this time. Please contact Project Redemptive Love for more details.

- Improving student achievement and work habits.
- Meeting specific student needs.

- Improving social and behavioral skills, i.e., better relations with peers and more effective conflict-resolution strategies.
