Family Life Center Volunteer Code of Conduct

1. Volunteers are not allowed to meet or call the students outside of Project Redemptive Love.
2. Volunteers are not to provide transportation for students.
3. Volunteers should not purchase gifts, food or drink for students.
4. Volunteers are not to initiate physical contact. If a child hugs a volunteer, it is acceptable to respond naturally.
5. Never engage in criticism of Project Redemptive Love staff or other volunteers.
6. Dress can be casual, but should reflect modesty and positive role modeling.
7. If a student reaches out to you with problems, that require specific help that you are unable to provide, please notify the Project Redemptive Love staff (i.e., Executive Director, Program Coordinator or the Athletic Director) for guidance.
8. Never criticize or make fun of any of the students. Please always edify and encourage them to be their best and perform at their fullest potential.
9. Volunteers are not permitted to date students that are enrolled in Project Redemptive Love programs.
10. Youth volunteers must remember that they are in leadership roles and must act responsibly.
11. Any violation of the above conditions will result in immediate termination of volunteer privileges at Project Redemptive Love and possibly further action.
