 - offering individual attention
 - reducing delinquent or risky behaviors by offering a safe, supportive environment void of alcohol, tobacco, and other drugs (ATOD) and violence
- improving social and behavioral skills, i.e, better relations with peers and more effective conflict-resolution strategies.
